


## Mp3 Lee Murdock - The Lost Lake Sailors

(WHEN THE WILLIE WENT DOWN) The shipwreck diver will enjoy Lee's performance of this Larry Penn song about the Prince Wilhelm II, a shipwreck which is now said to be haunted. (SAINT MARTIN ISLAND) "Saint Martin Island lays to the entrance of Green Bay ..." as the song begins, tells the story of a haunted lighthouse and island, just off Washington Island near Door County. (THE WARD LINE) Some of the sailors lost to the pages of history are honored in this traditional song, about black sailors working on the Great Lakes ore trade. This CD also marks Lee Murdock's return to featuring some instrumental guitar music on each CD.
