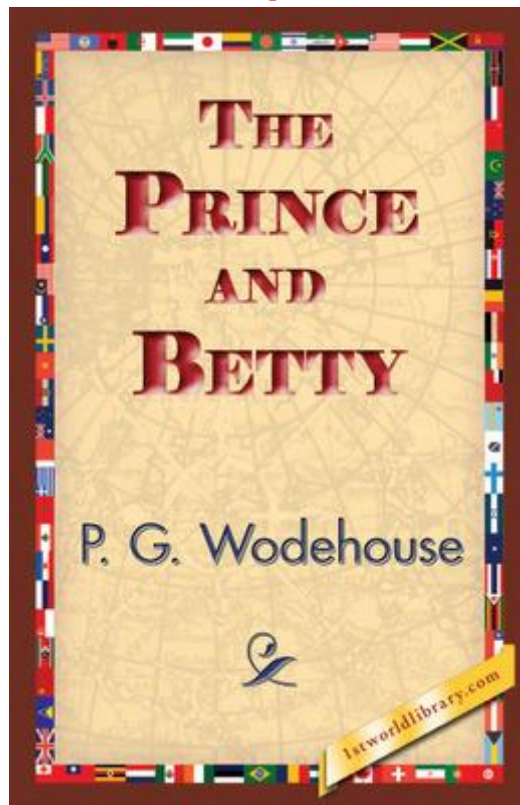


The Prince And Betty - P. G. Wodehouse
