But singing was over for me so I would always tell him yes but deep down inside I meant no. singing was like a deep hurting feeling to me . One day I decided to go to his studio cause he kept on calling me to come over. I went to sing on a poetry track by ----- I ran through it once and I heard it I was shocked but I remained humble I did it again on another poetry and I really liked that one . I never thought of making a C.D cause I wasnt a song writer I only had the blues in me. Tim let my brother(Mook) hear the music and he was also shocked, so my brother(Mook) began to do something he never knew hed do, and that is, he began to write songs for me and we all came together and made some nice music. It never crossed my mind that I would be on the radio, performing, making music, " especially not being on B E T or MTV" With people all over the world having access to my music! But its happening and I know this is only the beginning. Its hard sometimes but Ive done In a few months what it takes 2 to 3 years to do.
