King and the late great Johnny Taylor and the late legendary Sam Cooke. In 2001, Robert released two songs entitled "Playas Game" written by Robert and Brian Banks and "Take

Me Wit-Cha" written and produced by Joe Campbell at Quin Tisar Music, and recorded at Caswell Castle in Compton, California.
