He fondly recalls bouncing on the back seat of his Fathers Chevy Bel Air to The Beatles singing I Want To Hold Your Hand on the radio. It was a typically beautiful Dallas, Texas day, he says, blue skies and fair weather cumulus clouds out the windshield as we sped down the highway. It proved to be a seminal ride. He has been inspired by and passionate about music ever since. Ron played piano and violin as a kid in Texas. Moving to New York City as a young man, he took up guitar and harmonica. While living in New York, he played and sang around Manhattan and the Northeast; did some television and jingle work; was written up in the New York Times for his performances with The Rutherford Steward Band; and wrote and performed briefly with legendary rock pianist Nicky Hopkins. Ron Rutherfords musical influences are eclectic.
