Once they established a small pre-production setup they scouted for more talent and picked up Chuck, Marquis, Pat, and Marcus. Together they called themselves, Kinfolk Cuz, Head Busters, and finally Unknown Suspects and stuck together through Brians high school years. I. Present Time Right now Brian has been working on his solo project Stroker Style with the hit single "Get Your Money Right" and Boogilow and a duo album with Jyper Jay entitled "All B.S. Aside." Brian Williams A.K.A. Stroker received his Computer Engineering Degree from DeVry University in 2004. He took his DOCM certification classes to become a certified Pro Tools engineer at Stankonia March 13- March 27 of 2004 while in college, furthermore he produces, writes, arranges, engineers, records, and promotes most if not all of his music. He also works part time as a computer instructor/studio engineer at the Newnan/Coweta Boys Girls Club where he has built a Pro Tools recording studio and teaches the kids
