Fortunately for DALIDA MUNDALI that group was a big success. In 1990 DALIDA MUNDALI found himself at a crossroad and left his native land and French speaking Africa for Paris. As fate would have it DALIDA MUNDALI truly believed it was time to try a career as a solo artist and go global. Well from our perspective he was right. Songwriter, composer, producer, DALIDA MUNDALI is a powerhouse of emotion. In his composition and performance you can actually hear and feel the love and sorrows of the heart. The inimitable voice of DALIDA MUNDALI, is smooth and mellow. It is one of the warmest voices you will ever hear. In 1998 he released his first CD entitled Zalaka Mayl. With his love and knowledge of various music styles such as Ballads, Ndombolo, and Rumba it is no wonder that DALIDA is so accomplished and has such rich appeal. We expect that this new project will be just like with good old days of LOUAMBO MAKIADI and the BANTOU of the capital, World-Music and Zouk. If you were to ask DALIDA MUNDALI what is in his heart these are the things that matter: To make his music known world-wide; To play one day at Olympia (Paris, France), where all the great ones in the world of music played, including his idol GILBERT BCO; To see Africa find its true dignity ending wars, famine, and fostering democracy so that it can develop into the great continent it was meant to be; To make the world safer for everyone; To come to a place in time where everyone black, white, asian, and even those who consider them of mixed race and heritage are truly aware that all the human beings are identical; and finally but most importantly To see racism disappear forever!
