
Mp3 Dave Larsen - Plains, Trains, & Mules

With the release of his new CD, Plains, Trains Mules, Dave lets everyone know what many of us already knew: this fellow can just flat out write good songs. He writes much like the crafter of great shor stories; he is a precise narrator of our collective saga and can spin his yarn within the song format.
