Debi partnered with Grammy Award Winner Rubn Blades in his current international release "Concepts" a diverse compilation of rock and pop musicians from North and South America. Rubn Blades has chosen to use Internet as the only channel of distribution of his new disc, "Concepts." These musical works are available now, and breaks all the schemes of previous works of the Panamanian, as much in style as in distribution. Amp Energy Drink, by Mt.Dew/Pepsi, created the AMP Music Circuit and has been providing talented bands with national exposure, radio play, tour support and distribution.
