

As his interest and knowledge increased, Hura built an in home studio where he was able to hone his skills as a producer. As of today, Hura now has a library of his own original music, has played keyboard for several singing groups, and has written and produced for local artists such as jazz singer Laticia Carrington, R&B singer Cedric Clark, No Skillz, and Hip Hop group Black n Attack.
