Jake was influenced by great songwriters like Jerry Jeff Walker, Lyle Lovett, Ryan Adams, Gordon Lightfoot and Joe Ely. He credits Pat Green's first live album "Here We Go" as the album that opened up his eyes to Texas Music." "One summer at church camp my friend Angela Surber loaned me her CD player for two weeks. The only country CD she had was her big brother's copy of "Here We Go". Everything else she had in her collection was stuff I wasn't interested in so I listened to Pat Green. At the time I had never heard of Pat Green I wasn't that familiar with "Texas Music"." Jake was recently selected to write and record a song for the Texas Forest Service.
