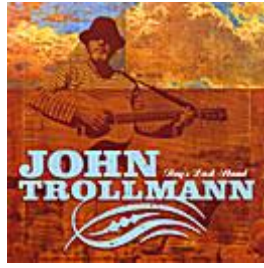


## Mp3 John Trollmann - Ray's Last Stand

Details: John Trollmann was influenced by the lyrical songs of Woody Guthrie, Bob Dylan, The Beatles, admires the folk/rock/blues songwriting of John Prine, Peter Case and Dave Alvin, and the regional songwriting of Mike Beck and Tom Russell that recall the arid wide open landscape of California and the West. God didnt have to travel far to out do himself. Its all right here. John lives in the seaport town of San Pedro, CA. Rays Last Stand was produced by songwriter and fellow traveler Gil Dabney.
