After the tour the band went their seperate ways. Bruce went on to

become a studio musician recording with artist's such as. George and Gwen McCrae, Dave "Baby"Cortez Life, USA...and many local groups in the NYC area. Since then Bruce has become a successful Master, Carpenter, and owns his own construction company. Kevin Kearny picked up the guitar at the age of 10 and hasn't put it down since. He was the All American Boy. Bright, Great Athlete and Handsome. He starred at U.C. Berkeley in baseball and was on his way to the major leagues with the Oakland A's organization when a back injury cut him short. He was a railroad man for several years.
