His education continues to this day, deepening and broadening through a variety of researches best characterized as the field of Human Development and Education. The world of child education opened up when he became a father of two boys. His primary wish as a parent was to provide a rich and

loving educational environment in the home and family life which included natural human theater arts. And thus the adventure into childrens education began!
