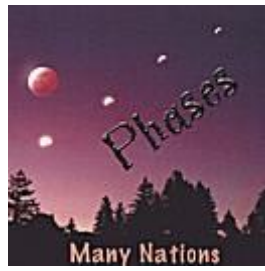


Mp3 Many Nations / Thayne & Taiowa Hake - Phases
