The band has appeared with local Philadelphia favorites including John Flynn, Lisa Beth-Weber, Mercy River, Martin's Dam and The Rigbees. In the studio, the Stephen Parker Band has recorded with members of The Eagles, members of the Garth Brooks band, and Elvis Costello's band.
