
Mp3 Scott Von - Moving Stones

Recorded in an old farmhouse in Maine, the album captures the boot stompin vibe of a live room, while melding the sounds of trumpet, dobro, piano, lap steel, upright bass, drums and percussion. The songwriting this time around has a palpable intimacy, and the musicians take risks with some hearty extended musical jams. So get ready to be lifted up and taken on a musical romp through the up's and down's of an American life. This singer-songwriter is winning fans for good reason: he offers up stirring grooves from the roots music tradition, can strip it down and deliver it bare and vulnerable like the best artists of the folk tradition, and takes musical risks by mingling with musicians who play jazz. This album has all that and more, and as one reviewer wrote: "Moving stones leaves you feeling better for having listened..."
