Her first self-released album, "A Million Light Years Long" (2005), was a special limited edition batch of individually packaged CD's, all signed and numbered by Lauren and featuring a handful of her unique songs. A segment on the making of her album was featured on KQED, the Nationally recognized San Francisco PBS television station, for their show entitled Spark, which highlights the finest local and upcoming Bay Area artists. Lauren has recently completed her second album, "In My Bones", a collection of songs that weave evocative yet plain spoken poetry with haunting melodies, backed up by her intricate fingerpicking and masterful production. The album promises to be a moving portrait of her rootsy, hands-on upbringing, paying homage to her eclectic musical influences and blending it with the skill and eloquence of a true singer/songwriter. At the age of

eighteen Lauren has appeared at numerous Bay Area clubs and coffee houses, as well as the Sausalito Arts Festival, The High Sierra Music Festival, and more recently performed at a tribute concert to Bob Dylan in New York City, to benefit the Music For Youth Foundation.
