Gordon Earl is an emerging songwriter, and fantastic saxophonist known for his big pure tone and lightning speed. While his music genre is pop rock, its infusion with classical instrumentation, and modal jazz qualities makes his body of work appeal to a wide range of audiences. Inspired by his elementary school band teacher Ralph Abernathy, Gordon honed his skills first on clarinet. He attended the renowned Interlochen Arts Academy, and he became the principle clarinetist in the Chicago Youth Symphony Orchestra. Gordon Earl studied privately with Chicago Symphony Orchestra clarinetist, Walter Wollwage. Branching out, Gordon studied jazz piano with the great Willie Pickens. At 18, he moved to the West Coast to attend Stanford University. In the 1980s, Gordon played saxophone in many San Francisco Bay Area nightclubs both with original rock musician Michael Ross and also in a popular Mo-Town cover group called Violet Fox. However it wasnt until the eve of his 40th birthday, Gordon Earl made a concerted effort to pull together two decades of his original compositions and produce his first album. He went to work polishing up his vocal technique with Sue Govali, who sang with the Moody Blues in the 90s, and Gordon began learning everything he could about audio and midi recording. His first album, released in July 2006, is called Big Questions. Favorite pieces on Big Questions include What Your Teacher Told You, How Could It Be, All Wrong, It Isn't Fair to Me, Do Me A Favor, Hope and Pray, Came Home Late, and the ground breaking politically charged song, The Database. Gordon Earl's second album, new this year, is The Answers. This release features the songs Corporate Tool, Save The Universe, Hear The Kaboom, Who Are You People, Drive With Me, the namesake track The Answers, and Fly to Paris, which took honors in the 2007 14th Annual Billboard

International Song Writing Contest. The themes of Big Questions and the The Answers focus on the powerful and enigmatic cycles of love, the desperation of the individual in a world in environmental and cultural turmoil. They address meaning and purpose, and the yearning for understanding. Both albums were composed, performed and produced it their entirety by Gordon Earl. Endlessly nuanced, emotionally riveting, magnetic melodies, and deeply satisfying poetic lyricism, are just a few of the flattering descriptions of his music. Gordon Earl lives and plays in the San Francisco Bay Area.
