He is a prize winning traditional dancer and is well known on the pow-wow circuit. Tree has performed before the Queen of England. All songs on White Buffalo are original compositions, some motifs are drawn from the ancient musical literature and are given a rich musical bed by Rob Wallace who artfully wraps the flute around accompaniment and solos unheard of in true Native American music. Will Clipman, another non-Native American, brings an almost divine consciousness with his organic and insightful drumming styles.
