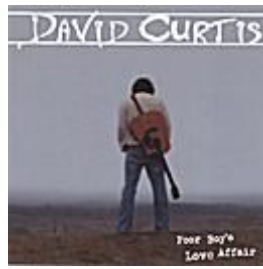


# Mp3 David Curtis - Poor Boy's Love Affair
