He loves Derrida, Chicago, and sometimes fire, but is indifferent to Stewart and never likes jail. On airplanes he prefers the window seat and on road trips he prefers I-90, listening to alt-rock women of the 1990s..."and the other one's playing a piano." Ian Wilsons debut self-release, The Crater EP, combines lans folk-rock and classical influences with the energy and humor of his live solo performances. The title track bridges the wide span of imagery, history, and cultural critique that personify lans songwriting. Known for his surprising lyrics, The Crater EP evokes comparisons from the metaphysics of Modest Mouse to the emotional transparency of Tori Amos. With a sardonic sense of humor, tracks like Andrew and Inanimate Objects flirt with the darker side of narrative, while Lets Go and Creative Writing Workshop reveal a more candid and personal voice. Unified by lans eclectic style of piano playing, The Crater EP opens wide the possibilities for piano-based rock.
