"Queen of Swords" refers to the tarot symbol of a woman "going it alone" after a period of emotional conflict. A middle aged mans desires for a woman half his age results in a lively debate entitled "That Would Be Like, No". The music being played at a belly dance competition provided the inspiration for the final track, "Soft Sell". Composer Mark Lopez has hoped to bring you into these pieces with a diversity of musical styles and moods. Moth Music will continue to explore instrumental music as theatre for the mind.
