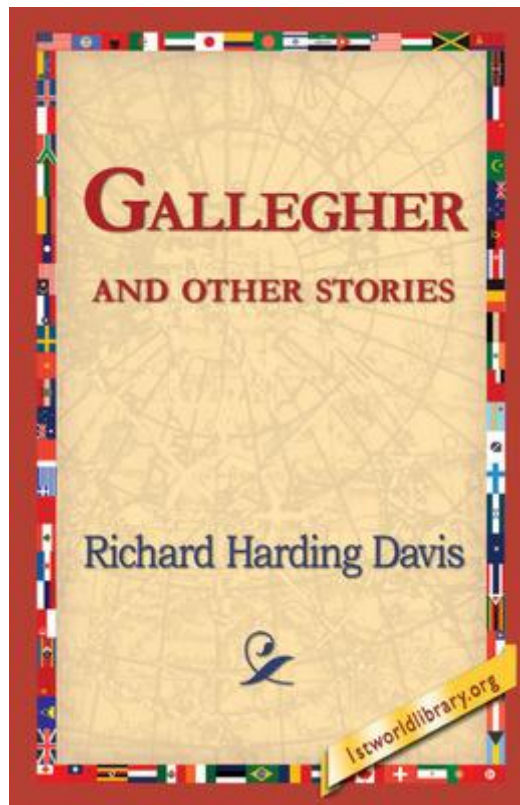


Gallegher And Other Stories - Richard Harding Davis
