
Mp3 Steve Coleman - Not Making Much Sense

Soon after the festival, Steve completed his debut solo album "not making much sense". Steve is proud to debut his self-released effort at the end of the summer, and will surely be promoting this rookie record. "For instance, the song "Closely" is about a father's love and overwhelming desire to be everything for his child. That kind of song needs a special audience, and Falcon Ridge was the perfect place to pre-release my album."
