As the Eagle makes it's descent towards the moon, an alarm sounds signifying a computer malfunction. Should they abort? The fuel is perilously low and the proposed landing area is covered in boulders the size of cars. Neil and Buzz need all their skill and training to land on the Sea of Tranquility. The Eagle lands with just 20 seconds of fuel left in the tanks. Apollo 11 has made history. Footprints Neil Armstrong steps down from the lunar module and becomes the first man on the moon. Magnificent Desolation As Buzz Aldrin steps on to the moon he

remarks on the "magnificent desolation" of the lunar environment. The two begin their work on the surface collecting rock samples and setting up cameras and other experiments. Beautiful Earth In all of the Apollo missions the astronauts were in awe of the beauty of earth. Our planet looks fragile from space. We need to look after it. There is radio blackout as they reenter and no one can tell for sure if they've made it. The astronauts returned to earth on July 24, welcomed as heroes. Parade The 3 heroes take part in ticker-tape parades across America and make the "Giant Leap" tour around the globe.
