My musical influences are all the classics: Hank Williams, Sr., and Jr., Merel Haggard, David Allen Coe, with a touch of Stevie Ray Vaughn and Buddy Holley mixed in. My band, Due South, and I have played at both public and private events, as well as doing the nightclub circuit and the occasional benefit. We were the opening band at the annual A-1 Trade World Show for headliners Doug Kershaw, Freddie Fender, and Vern Gosdin. I have also won numerous karaoke contests.
