Resource Music Pool, Northwest Dance, and Chicago V.I.P. It's now winding its way from Atlanta up to New Jersey, all the way to Canada! The CD has also received airplay from around the country, most recently with KCRW, and has been featured on NPR (currently in the All Songs Considered archive). Susanne Turner and Jazno Francoeur are the core of the ensemble (writing, producing, and performing) and are complimented by the arranging and performing genius of Paul Fleury (cello) and Dan Cermeno (upright bass). Mercymachine is a hybrid between Leonard Cohen's confessional, intimate style and Kate Bush's etherea. It is dynamic, dense music, reflective and introspective. "Many months ago I made the prediction that mercymachine would make it big; well, their time has come. This album of remixes has recently been featured on NPR and it's topping the dance charts across the land as we speak. If I have ever heard an argument for a remix album, it is this one. Mercymachine, made up of Susanne [India] Turner and Jazno Francoeur, has managed to expand on their ethereal consciousness mind trip-hop stylings by mixing in amazing deephouse ("Fountain Street" - Q burns abstract message mix), Hindi Electronica ("In Your Bed" - Asinine's Control Voltage mix), drum n' bass ("Quietly" - Pharm 13 mix) and world diversity that plunges us into a lovely boom boom abyss. "My Joan of Arc" playfully mixes in hints of "Ride the White Horse", creating a dark, funky voyage. If you have never experienced Mercy Machine, now is the time. Their usual dark and minor keyed sound resonates with Dead Can Dance, but this remix album turns everything on its head, re-inventing this supremely Gothic and Romantic team and delivering one of the
