So, together they all build up a fantastic opportunity for an old journey by music and concert. Because of this and the limited facilities to produce different kind of sounds, POETA MAGICA use their improvement to travel and changing through the European domain of middleage and folk-music without any divorce. The music of POETA MAGICA embraces from the roots of archaic, the time of the Trouveres and Minnesnger, up to the travelling musicians of the middleage and traditional folk, the whole

variety of the music from Occident to Orient. It is middleage pure in all of its variations. Timeless virtuous music on authentic historical instruments, a music, that makes your legs want dancing. The main purpose is to give an authentic demonstration of the middleage by music. POETA MAGICAs special ambition is to intercede for the convolution of the archaic musictraditions with the intonation of modern music, which is an old long heritage. It is an eternity from the middleage, over the Traditional-Music, up to the ethnically orientated World-Music as a tradition. Music it is a great variety of one thing called live.
