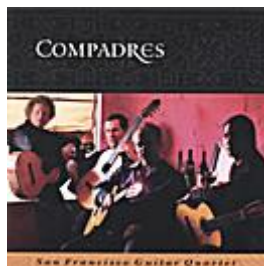


Mp3 San Francisco Guitar Quartet - Compadres
