After thinking about it more, we realized we were connected to the name on so many levels. There were three of us, all in our thirties (no snickering, remember this was way back in 2003!!), we liked that the name thirty three had three ts in it which represented the three crosses present on Calgary at the time of Jesus death, and we all really connected to the fact that Jesus died to save us from our sins at age thirty-three.
