In these diverse settings, Lystra's Silence has had the honor of performing with many of today's popular Christian musicians including Smalltown Poets, Skillet, Knowdaverbs, Rock and Roll Worship Circus, and Gryp. Because of their unique sound and quality music, Lystra's Silence was

selected to play alongside some of the biggest names in Christian music at the 1999 National Catholic Youth Conference in St. Louis, Missouri.
