
## Mp3 Naomi's Fancy - Crossing Borders

They have stayed quite busy since then. The group consists of four members - Naomi Orr, Stanley Widener, Craig Sexton, and Nora Garver. Naomi plays the harp, flutes, and penny whistle. Nora plays fiddle. Craig plays the guitar, mandolin, bodhran, concerina, and fireside pipes. Stanley plays the bouzouki, guitar, tenor banjo, and penny whistle (although not all at the same time). "Naomi's Fancy" has played widely through Virginia, North Carolina, South Carolina, and Tennessee. They have entertained at many various bars, coffeehouses, parties, weddings, colleges, contradances, and festivals. Their credits also include playing at the Festival Of Nations at Dollywood, The Sycamore Shoals Celtic Fest, Historic Bethabara Park, for the Irish Festival sponsored by Wake Forest Press, the High Point Theater, Dorton Arena, the "Dance of Nations" at VA Tech, local cable TV specials, and for the "Celtic Winds" radio program on NPR.
