Note: the online story is different from the audio tape. * Anansi Goes Fishing - a trickster tale from Africa. Usually Anansi the spider plays tricks on the other animals, but this time, things are a little different. * Juan Bobo (John the Fool) - from Mexico and Central America is one of the "noodlehead" stories found all over the world. "Noodleheads" do many foolish things, but they find wisdom and good fortune in the end.
