He is a licensed Minister of the Gospel and has held positions on the Ministerial staff of the

Christian Shelter in Salisbury, Maryland as well as the United Assembly of Christ in Bridgeville, Delaware. Prior to coming to the Lord in 1994, Moorer had lived a "colorful" life and could hold his own amongst many of the disenfranchised youth of his time. After growing weary as a sinner, Moorer had a personal encounter with the Lord that changed his life and shifted his focus personally and musically. Because of his troubled past, Moorer is able to reach youth with a troubled present and destroy the yokes of bondage through music, ministry and a powerful testimony.
