After recording their first three albums at New Jerseys renowned Trax East Studios with producer Eric Rachel, al james and dawn marie decided to take a new approach with this album. Recorded at Dirt Floor Studios in the woods of Connecticut with producer Eric Lichter, the dambrots took a very spontaneous approach to the recording, capturing the tracks in one to two takes, preserving the intimacy and immediacy of each song. the dambrots tradition of mixing things up instrumentally continues with this album. al james played many of vintage keyboards, including a Fender Rhodes, a Univox, and even a Little Tykes brand toy piano from the 1980s. the dambrots released their first CD especially not love in 2003, and declared then that they would record a total of eight CDs, one for each color in their logo. With this fourth yellow album, they've reached the half-way point in their musical journey.
