(off of only 2 albums) Good music sells it self...and this is proof of it!(no major deal, no distribution and no radio play what-so-ever!) up until now Immortal Soldierz cd's have ONLY been available through street sales out-of-the-trunk, but are now available for purchase right here on cd baby! the group has appeared on a nationwide compilation feat.- krayzie bone, cormega, twista, do or die, david banner, t.i., three six mafia, pastor troy, mike jones, paul wall and many more! Immortal Soldierz have also had a music-video played on nationally syndicated tv station "mun2" called "WE ROLL" (go to immortalsoldierzand see the music video!) the sound is like no other! mixing influences from hip hop, rap, r&b, reggae(with a gangsta twist) and rock and roll and yet manage to not sound to "rock and roll-ish" or "wierd" for rap/hip hop fans. if u are into real stuff, that has that lyrical depth, along with dope beats you can ride to and are sick of the recent up-rise in mainstream-pop-rap! this is what u have been waiting for! NO-bling,bling, NO diamonds or platinum chains, NO bentleys, NONE OF THAT "every thug needs a lady" crap,... just good old fashioned rap music that strikes a nerve and makes you rewind the tape to hear what the artist said!(man i miss them days!) A Brief description of the sound would be: a voice that demands your attention like a pissed off eminem/ludacris, occasional tongue twisting with

plenty of sarcasm and clever punch lines kinda like Chamillionaire or Tech N9ne, and the flawless enunciation of a Twista! the production is mostly done by DJ Don't Play who has that gangsta sound that would give Lil Jon and DJ Paul Juicy J a run for their money! the album starts off with a bang! track 1 has a re-played guitar lick from Metallica's "Unforgiven" played by in-house guitar member "ELLASAR" (that's right, ... we got a guitar player in the group!) and has a gangsta-ass beat behind it made by DJ Don't Play, the flow is tremendous on here, group member "Renizance" rips it like if there is no tomorrow on this one. track 2: "WE DONT PLAY" has no chorus! it is just a bangin beat with 2 dope ass verses, and some bass for ya 15's track 3: "pump, pump" has a gangsta-reggae hook, that reminds you of a 93'/94' Spice 1, verse 2 on this song is by "Renizance" and boy does he do some tongue-twisting on this one! (Guinness Book of World Records needs to hear this track! this boy spits 50 syllables in just 4 seconds!) track 4: "blah'zay" is just a weed song, with the basic essentials- a good to beat to kick back and smoke to, and a nice laid back flow about getting stoned-off-of-your-ass! track 5: "murder worth" is just 3 dope emcees, trying to out do one another, (luckily for the listener, everytime this happens... good songs are made!) after hearing these first 5 songs, u think to your self that the album couldn't possibly get better... but it does! tracks like "Anyway U Want" and "The Same ol', Same ol'" will have you putting your cd player on repeat!, and I can't forget the alcoholic/party animals anthem "Drink Up!"this one will get everyone who is wasted in the club, putting their drink in the air and have em saying "yeah im drunk and who gives a fuck!, I got one life to live, and I'm going to enjoy it.....bitches" hip hop/rap influences: Ludacris, 2 Pac, Dr Dre, Eminem, Tech N9ne, Twista, Chamillionaire, Rakim, Method Man, UGK, Scarface and Ice Cube rock influences: Metallica(earlier stuff), Pantera, Chevelle, Slipknot(newer stuff), Staind, Def Tones, Tool etc...
