Harriet is packing them in with her dynamic live performances, so look for her to come your way on her summer release tour of "A Better Life." This album celebrates love and loss and risk-taking. The hauntingly beautiful Celtic ballad "Ireland" addresses an antique family violin of unknown origin, except for the scant piece of information that it came from County Cook. Edgy country rock tune "The Further I Fall" was written after the Enron collapse and is a rallying cry for workers everywhere. "Baby You've Got My Heart," and "Bring You Back to Life" are soul rocking tunes that you'll be singing along with from the beginning, and the rousing anthem "Stand With Me" will have you raising your candles, lighters, and anything else aflame! The blues ballad "Belle of the Ball" honors the tragic figure of Blanche Dubois in Tennessee Williams' "A Streetcar Named Desire." This sophomore CD refutes the myth of the sophomore slump for musicians. Its poignant, eclectic edge moves forward a career that you

want to watch--to say "I was with her from the beginning," as the buzz on this great entertainer grows!
