Williams, Spyro Gyra), blended in his bass playing expertise. Rosanna was so blessed to be supported and surrounded with such wonderful Christian players. She has also shared the stage with Kim Hill, Andre Crouch, and Joel Hansen of PFR. Rosanna currently leads worship for various churches, evangelical outreaches, coffee houses and outdoor music festivals. In the past few months, she sang in Michigan, South Dakota, Minnesota, Illinois, California, North Carolina, Virginia, Wisconsin and Toronto, CANADA, with more touring ahead.
