Venues she has appeared at include: Katerina's, Grant Park, Magnum's Steakhouse, Davenport's, Gold Star Sardine Bar, Martyr's, and Joy Blue. Heather is currently singing in the critically acclaimed musical trio, 3 Girls 3, performing a nostalgic '40s show, a Burt Bacharach review, and a Christmas show. Frequently, Heather can be seen singing jazz standards with the Damian Espinosa Quartet and with Alan Gresick's eighteen piece Swing Shift Orchestra.
