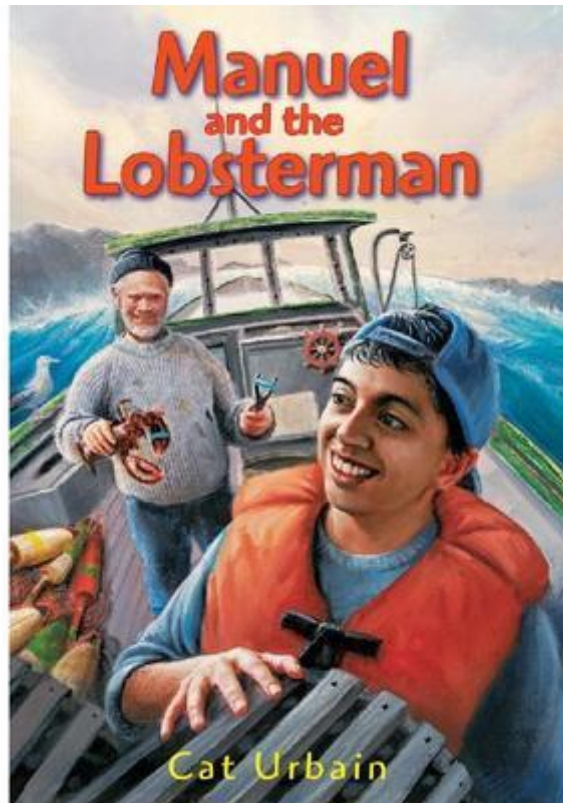


Manuel And The Lobsterman - Catherine Urbain
