Perpetual Motion: Another song by Alter Ego: Funkenstone: This bassline is stupid mad scientest style. While they said it couldn't be done funkenstone explains how he invented perpetual motion. 13. Straight Out The Jungle: Yet another alter ego of mine: Bigfoot. Bigfoot is an actual bigfoot creature that has come out of the wild on occaision to rock realism on the mike.
