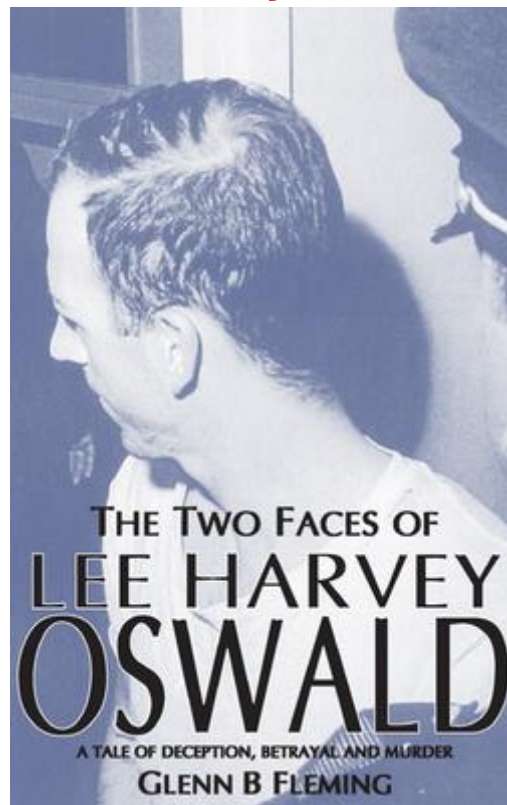


# The Two Faces Of Lee Harvey Oswald - Glenn B. Fleming
