Anje Seufert started her musical journey as an infant dancing in her crib to music played by her father, who is also a musician. Performing came naturally to her as she sang in the church choir and developed a love for the stage. She played piano and clarinet through school and studied voice and guitar. Her roots are those of a singer and songwriter both of which she brings to matador red. Greg Pancake started music at a young age beginning with piano lessons and junior high band. After a stint during college performing at a coffeehouse on piano AND gourd shaker at the same time, it was suggested he take up drumming and the rest, as they say, is history.
