By the time Monk reached age 18 he had released his first CD entitled "My Dope's My Music". He also began performing at various shows and promoting his career. In the first three months of the initial release "My Dope's My Music" sold around 1,500 copies. When Monk reached age 20 he began recording his second album entitled "About Face". The second album shook up the streets at the initial release and shined a little light on a promising career in music. Within the first three months approximately 2,800 copies were sold at concerts and through "street marketing" methods. Monk's newest project entitled "Writer's Block" focuses on the everyday struggle in dealing with being true the streets that he grew up in and the commercialism in the music industry. Monk intends to bring his own brand of "street pop" to the masses with a variety of tracks demonstrating his lyrical prowess in addition to top-notch production by producer Rud'e Martin. Rud'e Martin is currently working with various members of the group B2K as well as other related endeavors.

The first single off the album "Writer's Block" entitled "Jump Up" is poising itself to become the summer anthem of 2005. The "club banger", as proclaimed by industry insiders, has shaken up the club scene as well as given Monk the chance to show his versatility not only as a talented entertainer but as an underground legend.
