He received his BM and Master of Music degrees from the University of Utah in Salt Lake City and his DMA in music ed. from the University of Washington in Seattle. He has published numerous articles and done educational CD's for The Saxophone Journal and Jazz Player magazine. The group performing on Tower Blues includes John Paulson, saxophones and flute; Larry Price, piano; Terry Grosskopf, bass; and Rich MacDonald, drums vibes. This band is known for its hard hitting swing and repertoire of standards including well know bossa novas and ballads. In addition to being adjunct music instructor at Winona State University, Larry Price is a lawyer for the Winona diocese, Dr. Rich MacDonald teaches percussion and jazz studies at Winona State University and Terry Grosskopf is a free lance bass teacher and instructor in the LaCrosse, WI area.
