The Greek writer Penelope S. Delta was born in Alexandria, Egypt, in 1874. She wrote childrens books, memoirs, historical studies, articles on childrens education and welfare. She was a true philanthropist, a woman of remarkable spirit and intelligence. Her life was surrounded by political turmoil: her father, a cotton merchant who became the Mayor of Athens, was almost executed during the 1916 clashes between royalists and Venizelists; the diplomat and writer Ion Dragoumis, with whom Delta fell passionately in love, was assassinated.
