fan, you're going to love this tune. It starts off very slow and free with a beautiful melody that kicks into an upbeat Latin groove. 2. Pass It On - Robby brought in his friend and Award Winner Kellee Patterson to sing this melodic song about The Twin Towers and 9-11. " Before Theworld we saw, the twin towers fall...In disbelief we watched the horror of it all. But if you find some real wisdom, then what you do is Pass It On...". 3. The Cool Players Groove Tune - All the players on Robby's CD are Cool Players and wrote a groove tune just for them. A hint of George Benson/Wes Montgomery in the intro with Dave Stambaugh playing a hot Sax solo on this cut. You'll be tapping your foot! 4.
