Enhanced by the tasteful production of Kalai and seasoned playing of bassist Eric Wallengren, Sample's music evolves and stretches into grand new territory. The songs remain the story, but the colors- bouzouki, drums, dobro, harmonica- are all new. "Rotate" is the story of a girl with involuntary wanderlust, having moved over 21 times from Georgia to California, Utah to Texas. Like many debut albums, it chronicles over seven years of living, documenting a spread of changes and challenges. The songs cover a broad sweep of influences, from Patty Griffin's heartstring folk and Joni Mitchell's poetic vision to the loving-pleading-oh-baby soul of Otis Redding.
