

The new album "Honky Tonk Hero" will be released on July 12th and will feature current Whiskey River Band members Dave Walker on Drums, Chuck Amidon on guitar and harmonica, Ira Sherman on bass and backing vocals as well as new band addition Scott Dinolfi on acoustic guitar and vocals, "Long Time Coming" guitarist Mark Johnson on guitar, Tommy Alderson on guitar, Delaware native Wayne Tyler on Pedal Steel, Jeff Duffield on keyboards and Nashville session player/Grand Ole Opry performer Travis Wetzel on fiddle and mandolin.
